


Registration and acceptance

COVID-19 infection prevention



Safety and hygiene rules for everyone

- **Stay at home if you have one of the following (mild) complaints: a cold, coughing, respiratory problems or fever (from 38°C).**
- **Stay at home if someone in your household has a fever (from 38°C) and/or respiratory problems.**
- **Stay at home if anyone in your household has tested positive for the coronavirus (COVID-19).**
- **Keep 1.5 meters (two arm lengths) away from any other person outside your household.**
- **Cough and sneeze in your elbow and use paper handkerchiefs.**
- **Wash your hands regularly with soap and water.**
- **Don't shake hands and avoid touching your face.**

In close cooperation with KNMV, KNAF, Circuit Zandvoort and NOC*NSF, a protocol has been drawn up for organising activities at TT Circuit Assen. The protocol applies to all activities organized on the circuit. Hygiene of all attendees is paramount and the Dutch national guidelines are leading at all times. This is the only way we can use the circuit together and get corona under control.

Access to the premises of the TT Circuit Assen is only allowed when someone can answer all the following questions with no:

- Do you have one of the following (mild) complaints: nose cold, coughing, respiratory problems or fever (from 38°C)?
- Does anyone in your household have a fever (from 38°C) or respiratory problems?
- Has anyone in your household tested positive for the coronavirus (COVID-19)?

All organizers of activities at TT Circuit Assen must ask the participant these questions before accepting the registration. Only when the participant can answer all questions with no, the participant will be admitted and the registration can be accepted.

It is of course also important that the authorised team members of the participant can answer the same questions negatively.

We advise to ask the same questions again to all participants shortly before the start of the activity (e.g. the evening before).

When the participant and team members report at the entrance, they will be asked the same questions again. If one of the questions has to be answered with yes, the participant or the accompanying person in question will not be admitted to the premises.
