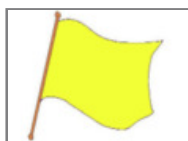


These flag codes are used by track marshals to supplement and support the digiflags.  
The signal that is shown first takes precedence.



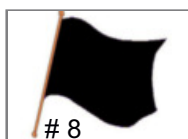
### **Yellow flag waved**

Indicates there is a direct danger either on or beside the track. Possibility rescue car on or beside the track. Riders must proceed with caution and be prepared to stop. Overtaking is forbidden until they have passed the green flag.



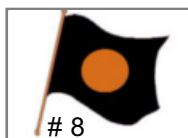
### **Yellow and Red striped flag waved**

The adhesion (grip) on this part of the track has been affected by an adverse condition making it less adhesive than the rest of the track.



### **Black flag waved in combination with rider's number**

Shown at the start/finish line including the riders starting number. This flag is used to convey instructions to one rider only, the rider must stop in the pits at the end of the current lap for instructions.



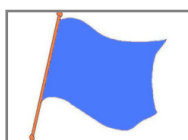
### **Black flag waved with orange disk in combination with rider's number**

Shown at the start/finish line including the riders starting number. Rider must leave as soon as possible the track in a secure way and stop immediately on a safe place. There is a suspect defect at the engine for example oil leakage.



### **White flag waved**

Slow vehicle on or near the track means proceed with caution. Overtaking of the vehicle is permitted with an appropriate speed but not another rider until the white flag has been removed.

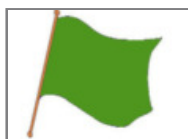


### **Blue flag waved**

You will be soon overtake by a faster rider, stay your own line.



**Red flag, shown on all digital flag panels simultaneously** - session is interrupted or stopped, clearly reduce speed, overtaking is prohibited, continue to pitlane and wait here for further instructions



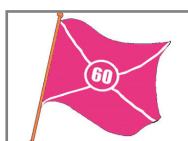
### **Green flag waved**

Track is clear after an incident has happened where yellow flags have been shown. It's now allowed to overtake again. This flag signals start training and race at the end of pit lane and also signal's during the first lap of each practice.



### **White flag with red cross waved**

It start raining in the next sector.



### **Purple flag / code 60, shown on all digital flag panels simultaneously**

neutralization, reduce speed to a maximum of 60 km / h, overtaking forbidden, mutual distance must be maintained



**Chequered flag, shown on all digital flag panels simultaneously** - end of session, overtaking prohibited, enter pitlane at first opportunity, attention when entering pit lane on other riders
